● SINISTER NEW POLICE FORCE

Labor's proposed **Australia Police Force** has already inspired protests from the Council for Civil Liberties, and from State and Territorial police. The new agency will operate nationwide, and will enjoy unprecedented freedom of search, seizure and entry into your home. This year, Labor ordered for the Australia Police the largest, most complex computer yet installed in Australia. The computer has the capacity to store a dossier on every man, woman and child. Why does Whitlam want this crushing new power? Built into the Australia Police is unlimited potential for growth.

● \$2,000,000 IN FINES — AND FREEDOM DIES

The Electoral Bill, a mass of savage prohibitions and penalties, is designed to advantage the ALP and its affiliated unions — while destroying competing parties, with up to \$2 MILLION IN FINES AFTER ONE ELECTION. This Bill alone will turn Australia into a one-party State. We urge you to read it, before you vote.

If Labor wins this election, it will be the last free election Australia will ever have. For evidence, read the proposals in the seven electoral Bills, and Conciliation and Arbitration Bills.

● GAG ON PRESS, RADIO, TV

Read urgently, also, the Broadcasting and TV Amendment Bill, which will end free speech on TV and Radio. Particularly note **Clause 6a**, which creates a dictatorial authority with carefully spelt out powers to do whatever it likes. The authority, a kind of socialist media council, will not be answerable to Parliament or the people. It will have power to dictate "THE NATURE AND CONTENT OF PROGRAMMES". The authority will have complete power over the NEWS and over CURRENT affairs programs.

● SEVEN RELATED ELECTORAL BILLS

Instead of unbiased recommendations from independent commissioners, for the first time in history Labor introduced **A PARTY POLITICAL ELECTORAL BILL**. Furthermore, the Labor Government made each State's redistribution a separate Bill = 5 BILLS.

● CONCILIATION AND ARBITRATION BILLS

These give terrifying new powers to communist minorities in the unions — destroy democracy in the unions (Clause 158M), weaken the powers of the Arbitration Commission (Clause 3, Sec. 2C).

FIVE BILLS WHICH FORM A PINCHER AND WILL SPEEDILY DESTROY THE PRESENT ECONOMY — CHANGING THE LIFE STYLE OF EVERY CITIZEN.

- **PURCHASING COMMISSION** would control almost 23% of gross national expenditure.
- **NATIONAL INVESTMENT FUND** would offer unfair competition against private investment.
- **AUSTRALIAN GOVERNMENT INSURANCE CORPORATION** will nationalise the insurance industry and gain control of private enterprise through investment channels.
- **OVERSEAS TRADING CORPORATION** could bypass Parliament, and have power over exports.
- **INTERSTATE COMMISSION** before amended by Senate, had powers of alternate government!
